If you registered for the marathon early start, please check in with the timer. The course is NOT supported during the first hour and participants are not eligible for awards.

You do not need to print it. We will need to scan the QR code on the receipt, though, so please have your email accessible on your mobile device or save a picture of your receipt with the QR code to your device's image library.

Social Distancing

This will be a traditional start. You can self-social distance as you see fit.

Course Info

Restrooms

Restrooms are available near the start/finish line and the aid stations.

Course Marking

All distances start and finish at the same locations. All courses are an out and back and will be on the trail 100% of the time. Look for 5K, 10K, half and full turn here signs. They are three feet tall and will be located in the middle of the path.

Open Road

This event crosses public roads and all runners must yield to traffic.

Aid Stations

There will be water, Gatorade, and GU at the aid stations. Some of the aid stations may be self serve.

Water #1 - Trail & Barton Rd.
Slightly less than 1 mile
Trail & Barton Rd. ROAD CROSSING

Water #2 - Trail & Lighthouse Lane
Slightly more than 2 miles

Water #3 - Trail & Sandy Ridge
Slightly more than 3 miles
7750 Sandy Ridge Rd.

Water #4 - Trail & Hwy H (MEDICAL)
Dairyland Seed
Slightly more than 5 miles

Water #5 - Trail & Sandy Ridge Rd (2).
Just under 6 miles

Water #6 - Trail & Old Fond du Lac Rd.
1829 Old Fond du Lac Rd.
8 miles

Water #7 - Trail & Rustic Dr.
W2151 Rustic Drive
Just under 10 miles

Water #8 - Trail & Century Drive
W2570 Century Dr.
Just under 12 miles

There are great stops along the course that have good parking available for spectators to stop and wait to see the runners. These spots are:

- Campbellsport Drive in Campbellsport (full marathoners only)
- Hwy H in Kewaskum (Near Dairyland Seed) (Full and 1/2 marathoners only)
- Hwy 28 in Kewaskum (Full and 1/2 marathoners only)
- Newark Avenue in West Bend (Near Lighthouse Lanes) (all participants)

Awards

Trophies will be presented following the race for the top Male and Female finishers. Medals will be presented for the top three individuals in each age division for all races. Finisher medals and t-shirts will be provided for all participants, including 5K run/walk participants.

Timing

The run is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.

Medical Emergencies

If you see a medical emergency, call 911. If an athlete needs basic medical care, proceed to the nearest aid station and a staff member will assist. If you have [symptoms of Covid-19](#), please go to the medical tent and self-isolate.

There is an automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit located on the timing trailer.

Weather

The event will be held unless severe weather occurs. In the event of severe weather, we will make an announcement to seek shelter and clear the area. All staff will also evacuate the area and will not return until the weather clears. We ask that you not return until we have made an all-clear announcement.
