Location

Packet Pickup – Rivers Crossing Park

3703 Rivers Crossing Dr, Waukesha, WI 53189

The Start/Finish Line will be on the trail to the east of the park pavilion.

Parking

There is very limited parking within the parking lot at the park and with the beer garden starting at 5:00 pm, parking for runners will be very limited. You are free to park on city streets in the area. Please only park where you can legally park and be respectful of the community residents.

Pets

Sorry. There are NO PETS ALLOWED in Waukesha City Parks -- you'll need to leave the pets at home for this one.

Packet Pickup FAQs

Can I pick up another person's packet? Yes

Do I need an ID? No way

Can I register at packet pickup? Yep!

Bring your QR code (Hint: it's on your receipt)

PLEASE BRING YOUR RECEIPT WITH YOU!

You do not need to print it. We will need to scan the QR code on the receipt, though, so please have your email accessible on your mobile device or save a picture of your receipt with the QR code to your device's image library.



Course Info

Restrooms

There are restrooms at the Rivers Crossing Park pavilion.

Start/Finish Line

This is a common Start/Finish line, located just east (towards the river) from the park pavilion.

Course Marking

The course is a single out and back. It will be marked with arrows. You should turn when you see the large 3 foot tall sign that says “TURN HERE.” If you hit Les Paul Parkway, you missed the turn!

Aid Stations

There will be one aid station on the course that you will pass twice (once on the way out, once on the way back) and we will provide water at the Finish Line.

Beer

You can redeem your free beer using the tags on your race bib.
You will need to turn in all three of them connected.

***Don't forget to tip your bartenders!**

0-14, then 5 year increments up to 90.

The male and female finishing in exactly the middle of their division will receive an Average Joe or Average Jane t-shirt and a unique Average Joe or Average Jane medal!

Timing

The race is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. **Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.**

Medical Emergencies

If you see a medical emergency, call 911. If an athlete needs basic medical care, proceed to the nearest aid station and a staff member will assist.

There is an automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit located in the timing van.

Weather

The event will be held unless severe weather occurs. In the event of severe weather, we will make an announcement to seek shelter and clear the area. All staff will also evacuate the area and will not return until the weather clears. We ask that you not return until we have made an all-clear announcement. Weather updates will be posted on Facebook.

In case you are new to Wisconsin, it is hot in August! There will be an aid station on course that you will pass twice. We also encourage you to carry a water bottle.

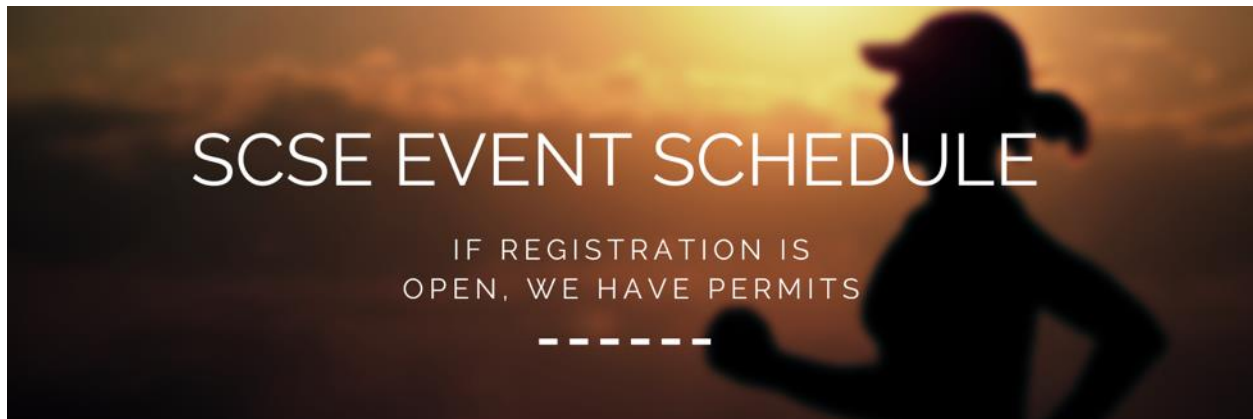
