## Course Info

### Restrooms

Restrooms are available near the start/finish line.

### Course Marking

All distances start and finish at the same locations. The course is an out and back course on crushed gravel and paved surfaces. There is one small section where runners will run over grass. 5K runners will complete one out-and-back lap and 10K runners will complete two out-and-back laps. The course will be marked with arrows and turn signs.

### Aid Stations

There are two aid stations on course. One at the turnaround point on the Lake Country Trail and the other at the finish line (near where the 10K runners make their turn to head back out for lap 2). Aid stations will have water.

## Awards

Medals will be presented to the top three individuals in each age division for all races. The 5K awards ceremony will take place about 9:45 am at the bandshell where the food, beverage and entertainment will be located. We will not be having a dedicated 10K awards ceremony, but will make sure 10K runners who placed in their age group get their awards after they cross the finish line.

## Food/Beverages/Entertainment

Food and beverages will be available for purchase at the band shell beginning at 9:45 am. There will also be entertainment at the band shell, and all participants are encouraged to check it out after they cross the finish line.

## Timing

The run is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.

## Medical Emergencies

If you see a medical emergency, call 911. If an athlete needs basic medical care, proceed to the nearest aid station and a staff member will assist.

There is an automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit located on the registration trailer.

## Weather

The event will be held unless severe weather occurs. In the event of severe weather, we will make an announcement to seek shelter and clear the area. All staff will also evacuate the area and will not return until the weather clears. We ask that you not return until we have made an all-clear announcement.
