Course Info

Start/Finish Line

The start line is located adjacent to the pavilion. Please ensure you finish under the finish line truss with your bib on the front of your body.

Course

This is a fast and flat out and back course starting at Sunset Park. There is a narrow, paved trail before you enter the Glacial Drumlin Trail. It is a sharp 180 degree turn to get onto the trail.

The turns will each be marked with a 2X3 foot sign in the middle of the path. Please make the turn

there. The marathon course will also have timing mats at the marathon turn. Make sure you cross those, or you will get a DQ.

While this is a path, it is a public path and there may be others on it. Please watch for them. All road crossings have public traffic and may not be manned. Please use caution when crossing roads.

5K, 10K, Half & Marathon = Super simple out and back.

Early Start

There is an option to start at 6:00am for the marathon if you're worried



about being able to finish before the course closes (1:00pm). If you decide to do this, you will be given a gun time of 6:00am. THERE WILL BE NO COURSE SUPPORT UNTIL 7AM. You will not be eligible for a Boston Qualifying time nor will be you be in the age group results, but you are welcome to start early.

To switch to the early start:

- 1. Go to runsignup.com
- 2. Click on Profile.
- 3. Scroll down to the race.
- 4. Click on Manage Registration.
- 5. Click on Transfer Event and follow instructions.

Restrooms

There are porta potties on site and on course. See Aid Stations below for restroom locations.

Aid Stations

There will be 9 aid stations on course with water, energy gel, and Gatorade. Aid stations may be selfserve. Runners are welcome to drop a bag(s) on course with their own hydration and nutrition.

- Mile 1.5, 24.5 on the Glacial Drumlin Trail (no bag drop)
- Intersection of Glacial Drumlin Trail & Wales parking lot Mile 4, 22

 Restroom location
- Intersection of Glacial Drumlin Trail & Country Road C parking lot Mile 6.5, 19.5
- Intersection of Glacial Drumlin Trail & Main Street parking lot in Dousman mile 10, 16
 Restroom location
- Intersection of Glacial Drumlin Trail & turn mile 13

Timing

The race is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.

Switching Distances

If you would like to switch distances:

- 1. Go to runsignup.com
- 2. Select Profile.
- 3. Select the race.
- 4. Select Manage Registration.
- 5. Select Event Transfer and following the instructions.

If you decide on the course that you don't want to complete the full or ½ and cut the course, please let our timer know when you cross the finish line.

Awards

Overall Male & Female

A first place medal will be presented to the first place male & female finishers.

Age Groups

Custom medals for first – third place. 0-14, then 5 year increments up to 90.

Medical Emergencies

If you see a medical emergency, call 911. If an athlete needs basic medical care, proceed to the nearest aid station and a staff member will assist. If you have <u>symptoms of Covid-19</u>, please go to the medical tent and self-isolate.

There is an automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit located on the registration trailer.

Weather

The event will be held unless severe weather occurs. In the event of severe weather, we will make an announcement to seek shelter and clear the area. All staff will also evacuate the area and will not return until the weather clears. We ask that you not return until we have made an all-clear announcement. Weather updates will be posted on Facebook.

HOW DOES RACEJOY WORK?

RaceJoy is a GPS-based tracking app that follows your progress in real-time as you run your race. Both the runner and the spectator must download the app, and keep their phones with them - but with a few easy steps, you have access to a number of fun features.

LIVE PHONE TRACKING

This is not an estimator and is based on the actual position of the participant's phone - your supporters know exactly where you are. Includes NearMe alerts and handy MeetUp feature.

GPS PROGRESS ALERTS

Receive progress alerts for yourself and others as you cross milestones along the course. Typically, alerts are sent at EVERY MILE, including location, pace, elapsed time and estimated finish time.

CHEERS

Your family and friends can send motivational, pre-recorded audio cheer clips or personalized Text-to-Cheer messages to race participants leading up to, during, and after the race.
