## KIDDO'S RACE/EGG HUNT

Bring the whole family. The Kiddos 1/4m run & Egg Hunt is only \$20.00, and 100% of the proceeds gets donated to [Silver Circle Foundation, 501\(c\)3](#) supporting our local police officers, firefighters and wounded veterans.

- This event is limited to 12-year-old and younger kids.
- The kiddos will use two different distances based on age and then enter the egg zone. They will remain inside the ballpark the entire time. Parents are welcome to sit in the stands and cheer on the kids.
  - Kids 1-5 will run from home plate down the third base line and then enter the egg zone.
  - Kids 6-12 will run around the park and then enter the egg zone near the 1<sup>st</sup> base line.
  - We will stage the kids by age at the Start in two different groups.
  - Volunteers will direct the kids into the field at the appropriate locations.
- All kiddos receive a finisher medal.
- All kiddos receive a youth size t-shirt if registered before the cutoff date.
- Kiddos can walk in the 2-mile walk at no additional charge if a parent is registered for the race.
- We have 1,000 eggs and ONLY 50 kids (so far)! There will be extra eggs in case the little ones don't get enough. Just see staff at the Finish Line.

Kids that are doing the 5K do not need to register for the egg hunt. They can use their 5K bib but need to stage according to their age. There will be plenty of staff/volunteers to help with this. The announcer will also provide directions.

Please bring a bag for the kiddos to place their eggs in. After the event, we ask that you empty the candy into the bag and return the eggs so we can recycle them. There will be egg bins on the field.

## **PARENTS – PARENTS - PARENTS – PARENTS - PARENTS –**

We need your help getting your kids off of the field if they are walking with you. The 5K run & 2-mile walk must start at 9:00. That gives the kids 15 minutes to hunt for the eggs and then get staged for the main event.

We also need everyone to get to the Start before 9:00 and start as soon as the horn goes off. We are asking this for two reasons:

1. The field is rented at noon and we have to be off of it by 11.
2. If we don't get everyone out quickly, we will have runners running into walkers. We asked the DockHounds if we could cut a giant hole in their gate to alleviate it, but our request was frowned upon.

## COURSE INFO

### Restrooms

Restrooms are available throughout the ballpark.

### Course

This one is super easy. You will make one lap around the warning track into the parking lot. You will then do two laps around Blue Ribbon Drive & through Wisconsin Harley before entering the ballpark to do one more lap on the warning track.

Walkers will follow the same course as the runners, except they will only do one lap around Blue Ribbon Drive & through Wisconsin Harley before returning to the ballpark. Kids that participate in the egg hunt are welcome to walk with their parents and do not need to register separately.

**WALKERS – PLEASE STAY TO THE RIGHT OF THE ROAD.** Runners will be running on the left side of the road. Please do not block the left side of the road.

Please note that the course will not be exactly 3.10 miles. There is only one road in the park and the city would not let us put a shortcut road in.

### Aid Stations

There is one aid station on course.

### Garbage

There will be garbage cans on course. Please use them. There is a tenant in the park that isn't so special event friendly. They will complain to the city if they find any trash, which could result in our permits being pulled for next year. Why can't people just get along?

## RESULTS & AWARDS

Finisher Woodles will be available at the Finish Line. All participants will receive a Finisher Woodle.

Results will be live and available on the [race website](#) shortly after you cross the Finish Line (about 10 mins). Age group award woodles for first – third place. Age groups are 0-14, then 5-year increments.

The awards ceremony will be on the pitcher's mound. Weather dependent. Bring your camera!

### Miss Your Award?

Medals can be picked up at the Silver Circle Global Headquarters the Tuesday following the race. They are located in front of the north entrance door in a black bin. If you would like it mailed, you can order it to be shipped [here](#).

## SWITCHING DISTANCES

You can change distances prior to the event through [RunSignup](#) – just follow these easy steps:

1. Log into your RunSignup account.
2. Go to your profile.
3. Select “Manage Registrations” from the race you want to change distances.
4. Chose the option to “Switch Events” to change distances.

If you decide to change distances while running – for example, drop to the walk distance from the run – no problem; just be sure to let our timing staff know when you cross the Finish Line.

## TIMING

This is a Chip Start race, timed by Silver Circle. Your time will begin when you cross the Start Line and conclude when you cross the Finish Line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.
