All entrance fees to Waukesha County Parks must be paid online prior to arriving at the park – please visit the following website for more information:

PARKING

There is no parking at the Start/Finish Line, and the road to the Start/Finish Line area will be closed to vehicle traffic at 7:15 am. Parking is available in parking lots throughout the park. Parking is NOT allowed on or along the side of any roads within the park. Please plan ahead to allow time to walk to the Start/Finish Line prior to the beginning of the race.

If you park at the beach house, there is a path between the parking lot (north side) and the road leading to the Start Line.

If you park near Family Picnic Area, there is a path between that parking lot and the Beach House parking lot.

It is a 0.75 mile walk from Family Picnic Area to the Start Line. Please plan accordingly.

COURSE INFO

The Flannel 5K & 10K course will wind through Menomonee Park on park roads. The 5K is one lap around the park, and the 10K is two laps. This is a relatively flat course with only a few small hills -- perfect for all runners & walkers. The 10K course is about 0.1 miles short.

NOTE – the 10K turn sign is AFTER the 5K turn sign.

Course Map

Walkers – for your safety, we ask that you start once the runners have cleared the Start Line. This will help avoid any collisions. Please stay to the right as you walk, which will allow for faster runners and walkers to pass.

We will use a mass start to begin the race, but the Start Line will remain open for approximately 5 minutes after the start.

Course Markings

The course will be marked with cones, arrows, and turn signs. 10K runners will complete two laps. After the first lap around the park, 10K runners will continue straight on their second lap. 5K runners should turn right to the Finish Line after their first lap. 10K runners will turn right towards the Finish Line after their second lap.

Restrooms

Restrooms will be available in the Camp Pow Wow Lodge and we will have portos near the Start/Finish Line.

Aid Stations

There is one aid station on course at about mile 1.5 – 10K runners will pass this aid station again at about mile 4.5. The aid station will have water (Orange Jugs) and sports drink (Red Jugs). There will also be water available at the finish line and within the Camp Pow Wow Lodge near the Hot Chocolate Bar.

While we strive to have volunteers at all of our aid stations, we cannot guarantee aid stations will be staffed. **Runners should assume that aid stations will be self-serve.**

Garbage

There will be garbage cans on course. Please help us keep our courses beautiful and place all trash in a garbage can.

KIDDO'S 1K RACE

We will start the Kiddo's 1K race at 8:45 am. The race is free, but ALL kids must be registered and wearing a Kiddo's 1K race bib. If your child is not yet registered for the Kiddo's 1K race, please be sure to get them registered BEFORE race day morning. You can pick up your Kiddo's 1K race bib at the same time you pick up your race bib.

RESULTS & AWARDS

Results will be live and available on the [race website](#) shortly after you cross the Finish Line. Age group award medals for first – third place. Age groups are 0-14, then 5-year increments. We will

have an awards ceremony for the 5K runners at about 9:50 am inside the Camp Pow Wow Building.

We will also have a short 10K awards ceremony after the 5K awards for the overall 10K winners. All runners should check the results when they finisher their race, and anyone who wins an age group award can pick up their award in the Camp Pow Wow Building at any time after their race.

Miss Your Award?

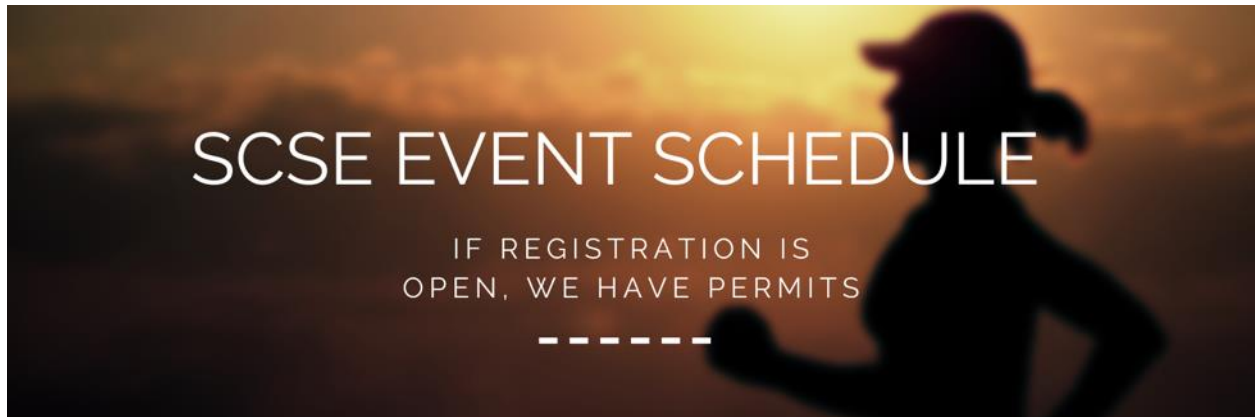
