#### \*\*Walkers\*\*

<u>Please start the walk as soon as the announcer releases your wave.</u> This is a common start/finish line and it is not large enough to have runners finishing as walkers are starting.

## Social Distancing

At all times, please maintain a 6' social distance from fellow runners/walkers.

#### Waves

#### Runners

There will be cones set up along the west side of the park. You should form lines behind the cones socially distanced every 6 feet facing west. The announcer will release you in waves every few seconds, starting at 2:00pm.

#### Walkers

You can self-social distance as you see fit. The announcer will release walkers immediately following the last runner. We ask that you be ready to start your walk promptly at 2:05pm. **We need to get walkers through the start line before the runners return.** Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

## Course Info

#### Restrooms

Porta potties are available at the park.

#### Course Marking and Closures

The entire course will be marked with signs and arrows. There will be officers at major intersections, but a portion of the road will remain open to vehicle traffic.

#### Aid Stations

Because we cannot guarantee a touch-free aid station, there are no aid stations on the course or at the finish line. You should bring your own water.

## Awards

Top 3 male & female run finishers in 5-year age groups will receive a custom medal. The awards ceremony will be at City Beach.

## Timing

The run is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.

## Medical Emergencies

If you see a medical emergency, call 911. If an athlete needs basic medical care, proceed to the nearest aid station and a staff member will assist. If you have <u>symptoms of Covid-19</u>, please go to the medical tent and self-isolate.

There is an automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit located on the timing trailer.

## Weather

The event will be held unless severe weather occurs. In the event of severe weather, we will make an announcement to seek shelter and clear the area. All staff will also evacuate the area and will not return until the weather clears. We ask that you not return until we have made an all-clear announcement.
