Charity Partner Silver Circle Foundation, Inc 501(c)3


We hope you will consider a <u>donation</u> to our charity partner. All funds raised through this event will go to troop care packages for the Fourth of July!

You may have to park in another parking area and walk to the start line. Be EARLY and please do not park on the grass unless instructed to do so by the park staff. You will get a ticket!

This is a traditional start. If you would like to social distance, we will keep the start line open 10 minutes.

Course Info


Restrooms

Restrooms are available in Picnic Area 2, near registration and the start/finish line. There are additional bathrooms at all the other picnic areas.

Course Marking and Closures

The entire course will be marked with signs and arrows. ALL of the courses will be on wide trails. You will never turn without the corner being marked with signs.

5K - 1 lap 10K - 2 laps Half - 2 laps + out and back on the Bugline each lap



Aid Stations

They are back, but we still strongly encourage you to bring your own fuel! We will have two aid stations with water bottles. One will be at the split and one will be at the intersection of the Bugline Trail and Good Hope Rd.

The split is where runners turn toward either the finish line or the Bugline segment of the course.

We suggest you bring your own water bottle because we find throwing 500 plastic water bottles in a landfill extremely wasteful. Yes, we know you can recycle them, but once they are mixed with garbage, they also become garbage.

You can drop a bag anywhere you want on course. If you are doing the half marathon, the Bugline crosses Good Hope Rd and is a perfect spot. The split is another spot that is easy to get to inside the park.

Switching Distances

You can change distances prior to the event by letting our registration staff know or you can do it by going to runsignup.com, profile, select the race, then switch events.

If you decide to change distances while running, just let our timing staff know when you cross the finish line.

Awards

They are back! In person awards ceremonies are back!

Custom medals for first – third place. 0-14, then 5 year increments up to 90. Finisher medals for half marathon runners

Miss Your Award?

Medals can be picked up at our office the Tuesday following the event. 2911 N Dousman, Suite 3 Oconomowoc, WI 53066 They are located in front of the northern entrance door in a black bin.

If you would like it mailed, you can order it to be shipped here.

Timing

The race is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.

Medical Emergencies

If you see a medical emergency, call 911. If an athlete needs basic medical care, proceed to the nearest aid station and a staff member will assist. If you have <u>symptoms of Covid-19</u>, please go to the medical tent and self-isolate.



There is an automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit located on the timing trailer.

Weather

The event will be held unless severe weather occurs. In the event of severe weather, we will make an announcement to seek shelter and clear the area. All staff will also evacuate the area and will not return until the weather clears. We ask that you not return until we have made an all-clear announcement. Weather updates will be posted on Facebook.
