Course Info

Start Line

The start line is located 2 blocks east of the Oconomowoc Community Center at the Oconomowoc Police station 174 E. Wisconsin Ave. This is the corner of Wisconsin Avenue and St. Paul Street. Runners will stage on St. Paul facing Wisconsin.

Course Overview

Runners will start on St. Paul running north to Wisconsin Ave. This is where all the Christmas lights are! Runners turn west (right) enjoying Downtown Oconomowoc's Christmas Lights.

The road will be closed during this time and the course will be led by a vehicle, but there will be cars parked on this portion of the course. Watch for any grinches who may decide to jump in a sleigh at this time.

Once runners reach Church street, they will turn south (left), pass the finish line (don't worry about the timing mats), run under the train trestle, and then a few blocks until reaching the Lake Country Trail.

Once on the Trail, please do not run/walk more than 2 abreast. You will pass the aid station at Roosevelt Park; the turn-around is about 1 mile later - don't worry you can't miss it. There will be lots of lights at the turn and a 3-foot-tall sign in the middle of the path that says *Turn Here*. You should turn there or you're going to end up in Waukesha.

Once the turn is made, it's all downhill from there! You will know where the finish line is because you ran through it earlier.

Please do not run/walk more than two abreast on the path. Faster runners will be approaching you on the path and they have very sharp elbows!

Course Map

Restrooms

Restrooms are available at the Oconomowoc Community Center. There are none at the start or finish line (though the Community Center is VERY close to both).

Aid Stations

There will be two aid stations on the course. Please place your cups and gel packs in the garbage cans.

Once you've crossed the finish line and cheered for your fellow runners, be sure to head back to the Oconomowoc Community Center to visit the free hot chocolate bar! Brewfinity will also be providing free beer to participants (21+).



How To Dress

Night Running Gear

This is a **night** run. The first and last half mile are on public streets that have streetlights. The Lake Country Trail does not have streetlights because it is not a street!

A glow necklace will be provided to all runners and you must wear it! You are strongly encouraged to also wear a night safety vest with blinking lights and a head lamp. When running with your head lamp, please point it towards the ground so you don't blind people running towards you.

Costume Contest

Dress in your favorite Christmas themed costume! The costume contest will be for best Christmas themed team and individual. Winners will receive a free entry into a future SCSE race of their choice throughout the 2020 race season. Contest will be held at the awards ceremony.







Awards

Awards will be presented at the Oconomowoc Community Center after the race.

Overall Male & Female

A custom medal & flowers will be presented to the first place male & female.

Age Groups

Custom medals for first – third place. 0-14, then 5 year increments up to 90.

Average Joe & Jane Awards

At all Silver Circle Sports Events 5Ks, we present the <u>Average Joe & Jane award</u>. The award goes to the male and female who finish exactly in the middle of their division. Winners receive a super sexy Average Joe/Average Jane shirt and flowers.

The race is chip timed by Silver Circle Sports Events with a chip start. Your time will begin when you cross the start line and conclude when you cross the finish line. Please make sure your bib is on the front of your body and visible to our staff.
